

Shareholder Event History

September 1999	Manulife Financial becomes a stock company - Manulife Financial Corporation IPO - stock listed in Toronto (TSX), New York (NYSE) and the Philippines (PSE) as "MFC" and in Hong Kong (SEHK) as "0945".
March 2000	MFC issues first cash dividend on common shares (for 4th quarter 1999).
November 2001	Canadian Share Sales program announced for Canadian Ownership Statement holders with fewer than 100 shares.
June 2003	MFC completes an IPO of 14,000,000 Non-cumulative Class A Shares, Series 1, TSX symbol PR.A.
April – May 2004	MFC acquires John Hancock Financial Services (JHFS) and exchanges JHFS shares for MFC shares.
July 2004	As required by Manulife's Plan of Demutualization, shares issued at IPO which are unclaimed ("Lost Holders") are cancelled. Asset reunification program to find Lost Holders launched.
February 2005	MFC completes an IPO of 14,000,000 Non-cumulative Class A Shares, Series 2, TSX symbol PR.B.
March – June 2005	Worldwide Small Shareholder Program offered to holders with fewer than 100 MFC common shares.
January 2006	MFC completes an IPO of 12,000,000 Non-cumulative Class A Shares, Series 3, TSX symbol PR.C.
February 2006	Dividend Reinvestment and Direct Share Purchase Program launched for Canadian and US shareholders.
June 2006	MFC common shares split 2 for 1 (by way of stock dividend issuance). New shares distributed to all shareholder of record as of May 25, 2006.
June 2007	Canadian Share Sales program expanded to include all Canadian Ownership Statement holders.
February – May 2008	Worldwide Small Shareholder Program offered to holders with fewer than 100 MFC common shares.
